

Musqueam-YVR Scholarship

Brief description:

As part of the Musqueam Indian Band – YVR Airport Sustainability and Friendship Agreement, Vancouver Airport Authority provides annual merit-based scholarships to eligible Musqueam Members to study at an accredited post-secondary institution. The awards celebrate diversity, and recognize various pathways to achievement including, but not limited to, engagement in the arts, academics, sustainability, leadership, aviation, and/or their community.

Eligibility / Level of Study / Value / Duration:

Musqueam-YVR Scholarships are available to outstanding Musqueam Indian Band Members. Recipients will be selected based on their ability to demonstrate their openness to continuing to learn who they are, where they come from, their responsibility in carrying forward knowledge in their community and a commitment to a sustainable future.

Scholarships are available to students entering accredited college and university programs and other undergraduate programs that are not direct-entry from high school. The annual value for full-time students is up to \$7500, split over two semestral payments of up to \$3750 each. The annual value for part-time students is up to \$2500, split over two semestral payments of up to \$1250 each.

Host Institution(s):

Musqueam Members may attend any accredited post-secondary institution in Canada. Accredited post-secondary institutions outside of Canada may also be considered.

Award and Disbursement Process:

An internal YVR committee reviews applications for completeness and merit. Funds will be split over two terms. Second term disbursement will require a confirmation of enrolment and submission of transcripts from the previous term at the time of application.

Renewal Criteria:

Continuing scholarships are based on academic merit and normally given to a student that is:

- Registered full-time in a degree program at an accredited post-secondary institution;
- Maintained continuous attendance, good standing, and passing grades in the academic session on which the award adjudication is based.
- Maximum of 4 years of Musqueam-YVR Scholarship funding available.

Deadline & Instructions:

The application deadline for Semester 1 is August 20th, 2026.

The application deadline for Semester 2 is December 10, 2026.

1. Complete all sections of the application form.
2. Attach required documents: Letter of Acceptance from school and transcripts
